The regular monthly board meeting for the Township of Wright was held on Thursday, May 13, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. at the Wright-Waldron Municipal Building.

The Supervisor, Fred Horwath called the meeting to order.

The meeting was opened with recitation of the pledge of allegiance and prayer offered by Roger Zimmerman.

The Board Members in attendance were Fred Horwath, Harold Douglas, Roger Zimmerman, Sharon Zimmerman and William White.

There were a total of nine guests present at the meeting, they were: Jeff Gier, Charles Meade, Shirley Meade, Kaitlin Vanderpool, Bruce P., and the government class of Waldron High School: Jessie G., Jessica Martin, Sam Stuck and Robert Bernath.

Correction to the minutes of April 8, 2010 was requested. Beth Town was listed with the Board Members and should have been listed with guest.

Bill White made the motion and supported by Roger Zimmerman to approve the minutes as corrected moving Beth Town with the guest list and accept the Treasurer's report as printed. (Treasurer's report attached) The motion was unanimously passed.

Public Comments:

Jeff Gier, Sewer Manager, reported that he had to replace a sheared off flex joint connection, which was cased from dirt settling down on the joint. The problem was that it wasn't back filled like it was suppose to have been.

They connected a new Sewer system on Youngs Dr. (Grimes home). Billing for this connection has not started as of yet.

Five homes remain to be connected to the Sewer system. Jeff contacted the Health Dept. about these remaining homes and has not yet gotten a response from them.

Jeff said that the lawn mower blades needs to be replaced, the cost will be \$132.

Sewer discharge was done last week, 4.8 million gallons. Hudson MI Sewer Dept. did the test samples, five samples at \$50.per sample.

Fred Horwath reported that the Road Commission has started to stock pile Lime Stone at his place for the Township.

Sharon Zimmerman reported on the following:

- Has additional check to add to the General Fund Bills: Ck#8769 – \$660.18, A&K Flag Accessories.
- Checks #8750-8755 have been voided.
- Additional checks to add to the Sewer Fund Bills: Ck#1203 – \$50. Reimbursement to Mr. Grime, this is an overpay on Mr. Grime's new sewer hookup. Ck#1204 -\$56.91, Consumers Electric and a bill to be paid to Sewer Tank and Pump for parts replacements, \$878.69, which is to be taken out of the RRI Account.
- We received a letter from Rural Development that the budget was unacceptable, Board decided we will let Mr. Rubley our auditor handle this.
- We talked some about John Pate spreading one truck load of free brine for us; we will wait till he finishes his applications and then decide where this load will be needed.
- Harold Douglas, Bill White and Roger Zimmerman will be working in Prattville at the corner of Prattville Road and Coman Road for the Spring Cleanup on Saturday, May 15, 2010.

Ben Wheeler's contract

Motion was made by Bill White and supported by Harold Douglas to give Ben Wheeler a two year contract at \$12,804.70 per year as Accessor Contractor and \$200.00 per year as Employee for signing the tax roll for 2010-2011 and 2011-2012, bringing the total for the year \$13,004.70. Monthly pay will be as Contractor \$1,067.06 and Once a year as Employer \$200.00 (monthly 16.67). Contract will begin June 10, 2010 end June 30, 2012

Motion was made by Bill White and supported by Harold Douglas to leave the 10% penalty on Sewer bills that are late. Motion was unanimously passed.

Motion was made by Roger Zimmerman and supported by Bill White to amend Ordinance 107 and make sewer bills due 30 days after the date they are mailed – changing the due date from 15 days to 30 days after the bill is mailed. Motion was unanimously passed.

Motion was made by Fred Horwath and supported by Bill White to approve the Cemetery sign that's to be made by "Collar Signs" – 24"x 48" at \$135.00. This sign will be placed on the building at Waldron Cemetery. Motion was unanimously passed.

Motion was made by Sharon Zimmerman and supported by Roger Zimmerman to pay General bills. Motion unanimously passed.

Motion was made by Bill White and supported by Roger Zimmerman to pay Sewer bills. Motion unanimously passed.

Motion was made by Sharon Zimmerman and supported by Fred Horwath to adjourn. Motion unanimously passed.
