## PUBLIC COMMENTS

Sharon Zimmerman asked the board to add check #1249 for \$495.31 to their bills submitted. (Sewer Supplies, JET PUMP & VALVE)

Clerk requested to take out \$147.31 in General Contingency and place in Elections – Service Account.

Motion was made by Bill White and supported by Roger Zimmerman to take out of General Contingency \$147.31 and place it in Elections – Service Account. The motion unanimously passed.

Cemetery Maps, Neal Hinkley said that he would like to have the cemetery maps updated, adding names on where needed. (Waldron, Prattville and Lickley Corner) then have extra copies made of each. Lickley Corner Cemetery is running out of grave space in the old part and Neal would like to get the plots marked out in the new section of the cemetery. We only have one map of Lickley Corner Cemetery, the board agreed to have two more copies made so as to have one to work on and one for backup.

We received a letter from the Hillsdale Road Commission about the Annual Township/Road Commission Meeting, wanting to set up a time that was good for us. The board agreed that January 20, 2011 @ 6: PM would be our first choice and January 20, 2011 @ 7: PM would be our second choice.

Hillsdale County Road Commission sent a letter, stating - Lickley Road in Wright Township, between Camden Road and Hartley Road/concerning repair of bridge/the road had been closed for repair to the bridge and it now is opened, there's a 17 Ton load limit and there are still a number of issues with the bridge, and complete replacement is still needed.

The Township received a PA-116 application from Craig and Kristen Kurtz, requesting the Township Board's approval.

Motion was made by Roger Zimmerman and supported by Bill White to approve Craig and Kristen Kurtz PA-116 application.

Roll call vote. Fred Horwath, yes – Bill White, yes – Harold Douglas, yes – Roger Zimmerman, yes - Sharon Zimmerman - yes. The motion unanimously passed.

### Jim Hnilo and Jonathan Kaoets from Ted Hartleb Agency

Harold Douglas asked Jim Hnilo and Jonathan Kaoets about the County no longer bonding the Township Treasures. The County is having a hard time finding an insurance agency to do this for them. Mr. Hnilo said they would contact the County Treasure and see if they can be of help, so as to get bonding on the Township Treasures.

Jim Hnilo and Jonathan Kaoets suggested that we adopt a Hiring Employees Practices Policy that way we would have it if we ever needed it.

Motion was made by Bill White and supported by Roger Zimmerman to adopt a Hiring Employees Practice Policy. Roll call vote. Fred Horwath, yes – Bill White, yes – Harold Douglas, yes – Roger Zimmerman, yes – Sharon Zimmerman – yes. The motion unanimously passed.

We talked about Life Insurance verses Accidental Death Insurance. They gave us some info about Life Insurance which was comparable to what we use to have but less costly and more coverage. Mr. Hnilo and Mr. Kaoets said they will come to our January 13, 2011 board meeting and have more details about the Life Insurance.

Motion was made by William White and supported by Harold Douglas to pay all General Fund Bills. The motion unanimously passed.

Motion was made by William White and supported by Roger Zimmerman to pay all Sewer Fund Bill. The motion unanimously passed.

Motion was made by Roger Zimmerman and supported by Harold Douglas to adjourn. The motion unanimously passed.
