New Business: We need to do renovations to the town hall to meet the standards of the American Disabilities Act. This is part of the requirements of the township for the Rural Development Loan. The motion was made by Sam Brown to approve, and supported by Roger Pitts. Ray Neeley, of Sue Lynn Court at Lake Diane, is having a water run off problem on his property, He could not be present and supplied pictures and told Supervisor Brad Smith that it was partially due to the township's handling of his neighbor's (Dean Doherty) sewer system. John Mason was not present to ask questions about the issues. John will be asked at next month's meeting. The township raised Mr. Doherty's sewer tanks to stop run off into the tanks from the water. But, the township did not put the drain pipe in to divert the water toward's Mr. Neely's property. Mr. Neely said the township told Mr. Doherty that putting the drain and pipe in place would solve even more of his problem with the water. The raising of the tanks have solved the water running into them. The drain and pipe was put in and paid by Mr. Doherty. The water issues that are due to the drain and pipe need to be addressed by the property owners. The Board will verify this at next month's meeting with John Mason.
