

WALDRON AREA SCHOOLS
BOARD OF EDUCATION

A regular meeting of the Waldron Area Schools Board of Education was held on April 10, 2006 and was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by president, Richard Storehalder. Members present were Robin Ryan, Scott Knapp, Dianna Oates, Harold Emens, Richard Storehalder, Bonnie Leininger and Tom Schaedler. Members of the audience joined the Board in reciting the Pledge to the American flag.

The Board of Education waived the reading of the minutes and approved the Waldron Area School District Board of Education March 13, 2006 regular meeting as presented.

Motion by member T. Schaedler, support by member H. Emens that the Board of Education approve and pay general fund bills totaling \$9,803.59. Motion carried 7 – 0.

Motion by member B. Leininger that the Board accept, with regret, a letter of retirement from Mrs. Sharon Zimmerman, Food Service Supervisor. Motion passed 7 – 0.

It was brought to the Board's attention that the athletic boosters are interested in paying for the transportation of athletes to Saturday contests but the original motion states that the athletes would be responsible for their own transportation. After much discussion there was a motion by member S. Knapp, second by member H. Emens that the Board clarify the wording of the previous motion to read that the Board of Education NOT fund Saturday athletic trips for Spring 2006. Motion passed 7 – 0.

Motion by member T. Schaedler, second by member S. Knapp that the Board directs the Superintendent to notify the three least senior highly qualified teachers that Waldron Area Schools cannot guarantee employment for the 2006-2007 school year. Motion passed 7-0.

In a Superintendent's report to the Board, Superintendent McGonigle noted that an adjustment has been made to the original school calendar due to cancellations for inclement weather; Wednesday, May 24th was originally scheduled as a half day of school but will now be a full day to make up for hours missed by cancelled school.

Motion by member S. Knapp, support by member H. Emens to adjourn at 8:34 p.m. Motion passed 7 – 0.
