

Ordinance to appoint the Village Assessor position

Ordinance # 2005-1

The Village of Waldron Ordains:

Section 1. Establishment of position

The village establishes the appointed position of assessor to perform the very limited functions other than those now assigned to the treasurer, the village assessor shall be chosen by nomination by the village president, and appointment by a majority vote of the village council set by ordinance as required by the General Law Village Act revisions of 1998 public acts 254 and 255.

Section 2. Term Office

The term of position shall be 2 years from the date of appointment beginning at the October regular council meeting following the Village of Waldron general election the second Tuesday following the first Monday in September on odd years.

Section 3. Pay

The Assessor's pay shall be set by ordinance and only adjusted by amending the ordinance with the annual fiscal budget of the Village of Waldron. Pay shall be paid annually at the end of each fiscal year. Pay shall be \$400.00 per fiscal budget year beginning with the passing of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective date of ordinance

This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the village's ordinance procedure.

Section 5. Adoption

This ordinance shall be adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members of the village council.

Section 6. Publication

The village clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by state law.
