

VILLAGE OF WALDRON
Council Meeting
August 9, 2005

The Village of Waldron held their monthly council meeting with nine from the area attending.

President Harold Douglas called the meeting to order by asking everyone to join him in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call of trustees was called for: Present were President Harold Douglas, Trustees Roy Hall, William Hall, Jeffery Bernath, Michael Birdsell, John Tanner. Absent was Christopher Crist.

William Hall moved to add to the agenda the following items. Sidewalks, Tree stumps at the park, basket ball pole and backboard, volleyball net. Supported by Michael Birdsell. Motion carried unanimously with one absent.

John Tanner moved to accept the council minutes of July 12th 2005 as written. Supported by Roy Hall. Motion carried unanimously with one absent.

State Representative Bruce Caswell was present to address the council and to answer questions.

Michael Birdsell moved to accept the committee reports as presented. Supported by Roy Hall—Motion carried with one absent.

Roy Hall moved to pay the bills and John Tanner for two council meetings that was attended. Supported by Michael Birdsell. Motion carried with one absent and *John Tanner voting no*.

William Hall moved to contract with the Jackson County Road Commission to Wedge, Sealcoat, and sweeping the streets in the village proper. The cost will be \$99,000.00. Supported by Michael Birdsell—Roll Call vote: Roy Hall yes, Christopher Crist absent, William Hall yes, Jeffery Bernath yes, Michael Birdsell yes, John Tanner yes, Harold Douglas yes. Motion carried with six yes and one absent.

John Tanner moved to acquire estimates on replacing the sidewalk on Center St., from the east property line of 105 East Center St. to west side of East St. and if within the budget to have the work done. Supported by Michael Birdsell--Roll call vote: Roy Hall no, Christopher Crist absent, William Hall yes, Jeffery Bernath yes, Michael Birdsell yes, John Tanner yes, Harold Douglas yes.—Motion carried with five yes, one no and one absent.

John Tanner moved to change the council meeting date next month to September 20th as the General Election will be held on the regular meeting date. Supported by Michael Birdsell—Motion carried unanimously with one absent.

Michael Birdsell moved to purchase a basketball pole and backboard to be set at the park. The cost to be \$575.00. Supported by John Tanner—Motion carried unanimously with one absent.

It was noted that estimates for a volley ball net to be checked into and also cost for removing tree stumps within the park along with sand and grading the volley ball area.

William Hall Moved to adjourn the meeting until Sept. 20th 2005 at 7:00 P.M. in the Wright-Waldron Municipal building.
