

ORDINANCE SETTING TERMS OF TRUSTEES

A regular meeting of the Waldron Village Council was held in the Wright-Waldron Municipal Building in the village on the 14th day of December, 2004, at 7:00 O'clock in the P.M.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Councilperson William Hall and supported by Councilperson Christopher Crist.

Whereas:

The council, pursuant to the provisions of the Consolidated Election Laws, has conducted a public hearing pursuant to notice within the Village; and

Pursuant to law, the Council desires to establish the regular election date for the Village after considering comment and input received concerning the Village's tentatively proposed ordinance setting the terms of trustees.

THEREFORE, BE IT RELOVED THAT;

1. The council does hereby approve the election of Village Trustees to two (2) year terms commencing at the next regular election date for the village, to continue hereafter until changed pursuant to law, if permitted.
2. This resolution shall forthwith be filed with the Michigan Secretary of State in Lansing, Michigan. (Courtesy copy to the Hillsdale County Clerk)
3. All acts of the village insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby rescinded.
