Council Meeting  
July 10, 2007

The Village of Waldron President Harold Douglas called the meeting to order by asking everyone to join him in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call of council was called: Roy Hall absent; Jeffery Bernath absent; Michael Birdsell absent; Rick Bays present; Richard Buck present; Bradley Frey present; President Harold Douglas present. Four present and there was three absent.

Rick bays moved to approve the agenda with the deletions and additions as so noted. Remove the item Water Ordinance and add setting of mobile home and also drains. Supported by Richard Buck—Motion Carried with four yes and three absent

Richard Buck moved to approve of the minutes of June 12<sup>th</sup> and the Truth & Taxation hearing minutes. Supported by Rick Bays—Motion carried with four yes and three absent

Public Comment: Village Assessor Charles Meade mentioned that there is (62) properties that the assessments was lowered on, but with the new homes and sales of homes the assessment for the total village will remain about the same.

There was more discussion on the code enforcement officer and wanting to put an ad in the paper with salary and hours negotiable.

There was no action taken on sidewalks, but noted that the property owners should be encouraged to clean the grass off and see just how bad they actually are. It was requested that estimates are to be acquired for the repair of walk on North side of West Center Street beside the Cutting Edge Beauty Salon and the wash out on the corner of East Center & Mackinaw St.

Have the village attorney send letter to Feller & Finch Engineers on the difference of opinion on the amount billed to the village for work done

Check on drains on the south side of Davis Street & at house trailer on S. Mackinaw Street.

Rick Bays moved to accept the reports by council committees as presented. Supported by Richard Buck—Motion carried with four yes and three absent

Richard Buck moved to pay the bills out of their respective funds. Supported by Rick Bays—Motion carried with four yes and three absent

Rick Bays moved to approve of the application from Myrl Meller to set a mobile home on the property at 325 Church St and is to comply with all the permits necessary from the Hillsdale County inspector. Supported by Richard Buck— Motion carried with four yes and three absent

It was mentioned that we need to think about the streets to be closed for the Labor Day Celebration, Tractor pulls and antique tractors or cars,

The council wishes to thank Bob Laser and those that helped water the trees that was planted this year, and to the Garden Club for the lovely array of flowers placed within the village.

Noted, that the new park equipment is in the process of being constructed at the Rutledge Memorial Park.
