

Call to order of regular Board meeting at 6:30pm. Pledge of Allegiance

Board members present: Campbell Evans Lantis, Vincent

Guests: Teneyck, Marsh, Sanfort, Berg, Billman, Parney, McLain Hall

Public Comments: McLain presented photos of King Lake Cemetery and complained of downed trees, cost of cleanup and the like. Vincent explained the contracting process for maintenance, capital expenditures, including the need for multiple bids exceeding \$7000 and his ability to commit \$500 without Board permission. McLain then asked that the Board address a zoning issue that the Planning Commission had already addressed and found to have no merit. Vincent indicated the Board would not address or take any action on Mclain's zoning issue.

Hall complained about a zoning infraction and the resulting fine. Berg addressed the problem, indicated that there had been ongoing problems that had gone unresolved. Vincent explained to Hall that once the infraction ticket was written, the matter was in the hands of the District Court.

New Business:By letter Mr. Wheeler presented an updated service contract dealing with equalization and related land information. It was agreed to hold the matter over until the next Board meeting.

Old Business: The progress of the Head Waters Recreation Commission was reviewed by Sanfort. The recently appointed Fire Dept. Study Commission had no reportable action due to the absence of any useable materials or documentation. A heated discussion followed. Vincent and Evans are to move forward in their investigation of the possibility of securing fire protective services from other legal and municipal sources.

The Sexton's report was present by Sanford and accepted.

The DNR requested permission to dredge Sand Lake. No costs were included in their letter. Vincent to follow up and contact Shirk if necessary.
