

WALDRON AREA SCHOOLS
BOARD OF EDUCATION

A regular meeting of the Waldron Area Schools Board of Education was held on June 12, 2006 and was called to order at 7:50 p.m. by president, Richard Storehalder. Members present were Scott Knapp, Dianna Oates, Harold Emens, Richard Storehalder, Bonnie Leininger, Tom Schaedler, and Robin Ryan. Members of the audience joined the Board in reciting the Pledge to the American flag.

The Board of Education waived the reading of the minutes and approved the Waldron Area School District Board of Education May 8, 2006 regular meeting as presented.

During the public comment section of the meeting girl's softball coach, Kathy Lockwood presented the Girl's District Champion trophy to the school. The girls not only won the District Championship but were also recognized for their Academic All State honors. She took this opportunity to thank the athletic boosters, Board, and community for their support during the season.

Motion by member T. Schaedler, support by member H. Emens that the Board of Education approve and pay general fund bills covered by checks #21098 through #21130 and #15922 – 15925. Motion carried 7– 0.

In committee reports, member S. Knapp presented a report from the athletic council meeting that was held on May 23, 2006, noting changes that are being made to the athletic handbook to be read later in the meeting.

The annual Reading Recovery Report as presented by Mrs. Lyn Snyder was reviewed at this time. Mr. McGonigle noted that the continuation of this program is based upon staff research and data analysis. This determination has not yet been made.

Superintendent McGonigle recognized Waldron Special Education teacher Kellie Fidler for receiving the Excellence In Special Education Award granted by Hillsdale County Intermediate School District's Special Education Parent Advisory Committee.

In old business, the Board conducted a second reading of the Control of Casual-Contact Communicable Disease Policy. Motion by member T. Schaedler, seconded by member S. Knapp to adopt this policy. Motion carried 6 – 1 with R. Storehalder casting the one negative vote.

Motion by member T. Schaedler, support by member B. Leininger that the Board adopt the 2006-2007 Budgets for General Fund, Buildings & Site Sinking Fund, Energy Conservation, Athletic Fund, and Food Service Funds as presented. Motion passed 7 – 0.

Motion by member T. Schaedler, support by member S. Knapp that the Board adopt the resolution authorizing issuance of a state aid note (see attached). Motion passed 7 – 0.

Motion by member H. Emens, second by member S. Knapp that the Board appoint Mrs. Cheryl Price as Waldron Schools representative on the Hillsdale County ISD Parent Advisory Committee. Motion passed 7 – 0.

Board President appointed member. H. Emens as the district's member of the Legislative Relations Network.

At the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Board conducted the first reading of the 2006-2007 Athletic Handbook as presented by Mr. Fred Bowers.

Motion by member S. Knapp, support by member H. Emens to adjourn at 8:59 p.m. Motion passed 7 – 0.
