

VILLAGE OF WALDRON  
COUNCIL MEETING  
March 13, 2007

7:00 p.m.

The Council meeting was called to order by President Harold Douglas in asking everyone to join him in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call of councilors was called: Present were Roy Hall, Jeffery Bernath, Michael Birdsell, Rick Bays, Richard Buck, President Harold Douglas. One vacant seat.

Rick Bays moved to approve of the following additions to the agenda: Treasurers report, Mobile home at 111 S East St & 101 Church St.: 410 S Main St.; Strike council vacant seat. Supported by Mike Birdsell—Motion carried unanimously with one vacant seat.

Richard Buck move to approve the minutes from the February 20<sup>th</sup> 2007 Budget Hearing and the Council meeting minutes as written. Supported by Mike Birdsell—Motion carried unanimously with one vacant seat.

Roy Hall moved to accept the Treasures Report as presented.

Total assessed = \$76,051.46; Total collected = \$67,967.81; Total to collect = \$8,142.83; Poverty Exceptions = \$83.17. Administration fee = \$751.37.

Committee reports:

Maintenance noted that some manholes in the street are in need of repair around them. Drain at 301 N Main is in need of being replace along with a larger tile put in to accommodate the amount of storm water in that area.

The Water project is underway, but not expected to take place until the year 2008.

President Douglas noted that he would see if the Engineers and Rural Development representatives would be present at the April meeting to answer any concerns of council and the public.

Rick Bays moved to accept the reports as presented. Supported by Jeffery Bernath—Motion carried unanimously with one vacant seat.

Richard Buck moved to pay the bills out of their respective funds. Supported by Mike Birdsell—Motion carried unanimously with one vacant seat.

Richard Buck move that the spring clean up would be Saturday May 12<sup>th</sup> 2007 with A.R.S. of Archbold, OH., to pick up. Particulars will be posted at a later date. Time will be from 8:00A.M.--1:00 P.M. Cost to be \$115.00 per ton. Supported by Mike Birdsell—Motion carried unanimously with one vacant seat.

The council noted that there are at least three homes in the village that has excessive amount of rubbish & blight that is laid around causing the neighborhood to be an unsightly site. These residents will be notified as to the ordinance and pictures may be sent to the health department as well as the attorney for any further action that will be necessary to keep the village presentable.

Also mobile homes that are setting around and not hooked up should be removed soon. It is possible that the water & sanitary *ready to serve cost of (\$29.50)* could be applied against such properties. Mobile homes on properties that are not acceptable should be removed to another location.

Mike Birdsell moved to adjourn the meeting until April 10<sup>th</sup>2007 in the Wright-Waldron Municipal Building, starting at 7:00P.M.
