

A special board meeting for the Township of Wright was held on Thursday, March 25, 2004 at 7:00 p.m. at the Wright-Waldron Municipal Building.

The purpose of the meeting was in regards to the Lime Lake/Prattville sewer system project.

The Supervisor, Fred Horwath called the meeting to order at 7:25 p.m.

The Board Members in attendance were Fred Horwath, William White, Roger Zimmerman, and Connie Strong. Lois Hills was absent.

Engineers, Ray Saneholtz and Steve Darmofal from Feller, Finch & Associates, Inc., and Attorney, Dan Boyd were in attendance along with John Tanner and Terry Rossi.

The meeting was turned over to the Engineer, Ray Saneholtz for him to present the items that needed to be discussed and the details that needed addressed concerning the Lime Lake/Prattville sewer system project.

Raymond Saneholtz started with the discussion of property easements in the sewer project area. He had with him large roll out maps color-coded showing different property types. Going over the different properties it was discussed how and which properties would be assessed such as homes, vacant lots, developable lots, farm ground, and etc.

Attorney, Dan Boyd discussed with the board his plans to step up the process of getting the remaining easements signed.

Fred Horwath presented the letter he received from the Road Commission along with the additional cost estimates that were requested on Burt Road, Coman Road, and Hartley Road. The Road Commission recommended not to do any road work on Hartley Road at this time. The projects were discussed. It was decided more information was needed in regards to the longevity of fixing Burt Road. Fred will contact the Road Commission concerning this matter. The projects were tabled until the April regular meeting.

The motion was made by Board Member, William White, supported by Board Member, Roger Zimmerman, to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 9:23 p.m.
