SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

Fire, Ambulance, & Law Enforcement Committee called for a special meeting with an agenda of Council Policy, Weapons, Code Enforcement Officer, & Disbursements.

President Richard Buck called the meeting to order by asking everyone to join him in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll calls taken by President Richard Buck. Those present: Rick Bays; Roy Hall; Harold Douglas; Jeff Bernath; and Brad Frey. Absent was Shawn Barnhart.

Roy Hall started the discussion consisting of council setting policy, which has always taken place. The weapons the Village owns are in storage at the Sheriff's office. One was removed by the authorization of the Village President. The reason being for the Code Enforcement Officer to use in Reserve class training for qualifying as an officer. This weapon is currently being stored in a locked box. The Council might look into selling all weapons at a later date. The Code Enforcement Officer is not carrying a concealed weapon at this time. The check disbursement signatures are listed at the bank with three names: Village President, Treasurer, and Clerk. Any two of the three signatures may sign a check.

Harold Douglas made a motion adjourn meeting. Motion supported by Roy Hall. Motion carried with six yeas and one absent.
