Council Meeting
May 13, 2008

President Richard Buck called the meeting to order by asking everyone to join him in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call taken by President Richard Buck. Those present: Roy Hall; Harold Douglas; Brad Frey; Shawn Barnhart. Absent was Rick Bays and Jeff Bernath.

Roy Hall moved to accept the agenda. Motion was supported by Harold Douglas. Motion carried with five yes, and two absent.

Harold Douglas moved to approve April meeting minutes. Motion was supported by Shawn Barnhart. Motion carried with five yes and two absent.

Roy Hall made a motion to approve all but two of the bills submitted. Motion was supported by Harold Douglas with the exception that the two bills be discussed. Motion passed with five yes and two absent.
