

A special meeting of the Wright Township board was held on Thursday, May 19, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. at the Wright-Waldron Municipal Building.

The purpose of this special meeting was for the Lime Lake/Prattville Sanitary Sewer System Improvements project.

The board members in attendance were Fred Horwath, Lois Hills, Roger Zimmerman, Connie Strong, and William White.

Steve Darmofal from Feller, Finch and Associates, Christie Cook from RCAP, Skip Linden, and Richard Chudey were visitors in attendance at the meeting.

The Supervisor, Fred Horwath, called the meeting to order.

Christie Cook presented a draft copy of an ordinance to provide for the operation and maintenance of the Township of Wright's Lime Lake/Prattville Sanitary Sewage Disposal system on a public utility basis under provisions of Act 94, Public Acts of Michigan, 1933, as amended. The ordinance was reviewed and discussed.

Paul Wyzgoski, Bond Counsel from Dickinson Wright PLLC, is in the processing of drafting an ordinance for the operation and maintenance of the sewer system, and for mandatory use of sewer system.

Steve Darmofal from Feller, Finch and Associates, was present to provide information on the Lime Lake/Prattville sewer system project.

It was the consensus to wait for the copies of the ordinances prepared by Paul Wyzgoski before taking any action concerning adopting ordinances.

Board Member, William White made the motion, supported by Board Member, Connie Strong to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried.
