

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE RANSOM TOWNSHIP BOARD
HELD AT THE RANSOM TOWNSHIP HALL**

DATE OF MEETING: May 10, 2004

TIME: 8:00 P.M.

The regular meeting of the Ransom Township Board was called to order by Vincent Smith, Supervisor. All board members except Ted Kneebush, Treasurer were present. There were (8) eight citizens present. The meeting was opened with The Pledge of Allegiance.

Rick Johnson, Clerk, read the minutes of the regular April meeting. George Clark, Trustee, moved to accept the minutes as read. Bob Billman, Trustee, seconded the motion. Carried.

Rick gave the treasurer's report, and read the bills and receipts. Our beginning balance was \$26,867.18, our receipts totaled \$9,346.06, our disbursements totaled \$8,862.14, our ending balance is \$27,351.10. Vincent moved to receive the treasurer's report and place it on record, and pay the bills as read. George seconded the motion. Carried.

George moved to sign contracts with the Road Commission for 1,000 cyd of gravel at a cost of \$3,750 and mineral well brine for dust control at a cost of \$11,625 Bob seconded the motion. Carried.

State Representative Bruce Caswell was present and gave a report and fielded questions.

We talked about platting the Power's Cemetery. George reported that Pete Peltier cleaned up the brush at the Power's Cemetery at no charge.

George moved to adjourn. Bob seconded the motion. Carried.

Vincent adjourned the meeting at 9:05 P.M.
