

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE RANSOM TOWNSHIP BOARD  
HELD AT THE RANSOM TOWNSHIP HALL**

**DATE OF MEETING:** July 12, 2004

**TIME:** 8:00 P.M.

The regular meeting of the Ransom Township Board was called to order by Vincent Smith, Supervisor. All board members and (11) eleven citizens were present. The meeting was opened with The Pledge of Allegiance.

Rick Johnson, Clerk, read the minutes of the regular June meeting. George Clark, Trustee, moved to accept the minutes as read. Bob Billman, Trustee, seconded the motion. Carried.

Ted Kneebush, Treasurer, gave the treasurer's report, and read the bills and receipts. Our beginning balance was \$18,439.05, our receipts totaled \$22,163.13, our disbursements totaled \$19,220.93, our ending balance is \$21,381.25. Rick moved to receive the treasurer's report and place it on record, and pay the bills as read. Bob seconded the motion. Carried.

Terri Gear gave a presentation campaigning for the Senior Center millage renewal.

County Commissioner, Alice Britton, was present campaigning for the 5<sup>th</sup> district commissioner position. She also talked about the ballot proposal for ½ mill for the County Building and Site fund.

Bob Godfrey was present campaigning as a candidate for Road Commissioner.

Keith Brown was present, representing Congressman Nick Smith. He gave flags flown over the U.S. Capital July 4, 2004 and letters to Ted Kneebush for 32 years service and George Clark and Rick Johnson for 20 years service.

Nick Wheeler – County Equalization Director gave a presentation on digitized parcels and aerial mapping. He requested that the township sign the Intergovernmental Data Sharing Agreement and contribute \$300-\$500 to this project.

Vincent moved to have Prattville Fertilizer and Grain fertilize the lawn at the Powers Cemetery at a cost of \$30 per acre. Bob seconded the motion. Carried.

George shared the landscape layout plan developed for the Powers Cemetery by Nancy King.

Ted moved to have Bob berm the ramp at the Township Hall to meet the Federal handicap accessibility requirements. George seconded the motion. Carried.

Vincent moved to adjourn. Rick seconded the motion. Carried.

Vincent adjourned the meeting at 9:50 P.M.
