

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE RANSOM TOWNSHIP BOARD  
HELD AT THE RANSOM TOWNSHIP HALL**

**DATE OF MEETING:** May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2006

The regular meeting of the Ransom Township Board was called to order by Vincent Smith, Supervisor. The meeting started with four (4) members present and seven (7) citizens were present. The meeting was opened with The Pledge of Allegiance.

Robert Billman, Trustee, read the minutes of the regular April meeting. George Clark, Trustee, moved to accept the minutes as read. Vincent, seconded the motion. Carried.

Ted Kneebush, Treasurer, gave the treasurer's report, and read the bills and receipts. Our beginning balance was \$34,071.08, our receipts totaled \$11,224.34, our disbursements totaled \$10,507.02, and our ending balance is \$34,788.40. Vincent moved to receive the treasurer's report and place it on record, and pay the bills as read. Bob seconded the motion. Carried.

\$350.00 will be paid to the Waldron F.F.A. for roadside trash pickup

Bob Godfrey spoke regarding the brining of the roads. They will start end of end of May.

Stan Clingerman talked more on the roads. He has been out checking out jobs on Ransom Road and Miller Road. Brining is done.

Brad Densmore said that someone will be appointed by the May 16<sup>th</sup> meeting for County Road Commissioner. This person will not be running for the August Primary. August Primary will include Renewals for Medical Care, Ambulance, 911. New millage for Ambulance and Medical Care. County is asking for a (1) one mill in November election for an elevator for the courthouse.

There will be services Memorial Day at 2:00. Pastor Marty from Prattville will be doing services.

Discussion regarding sand around the Cemetery stones was discussed. Also, had a discussion regarding a Cemetery Ordinance.

Transfer station will becheck for empty dumpsters before opening day, to make sure we had dumpsters.

George moved to adjourn. Ted seconded the motion. Carried.
