

Approved Minutes – Reading Township Board
June 14, 2004, Regular Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM with Dave Newell, Roger Wheeler, Ron Parker, Randy Wigent and Judy Wheeler present. Also present were Kathy Mikolajczyk, James Galloway, Mike McCavit, Sr., Art Thomas, Patty Siegrist, Judy VanZandt, Jerry VanZandt, Brett Hutchins and Chris Shafer.

The minutes of the May 10, 2004 Regular meeting were read and approved.

Judy VanZandt questioned the process of getting the roads paved at Totem Village. The Township Attorney will review this and then the township board will develop a possible plan for review.

Road Commissioner, Bret Hutchins asked that the Township make a decision on whether or not to go any further on the Wildwood Road/ Crawford Road erosion control project. There was a motion by Dave Newell supported by Randy Wigent to discontinue any efforts to obtain grant money for this erosion control project and do no more on the project. This motion carried 5-0.

A road commission proposal for breaking up Humphry Road was given to the Township.

There was a long discussion of Chris Shafer's request for a conditional use permit for a storage facility. There was a motion by Roger Wheeler supported by Ron Parker to approve this conditional use permit with the conditions recommended by the Planning Commission except that the hours of operation would be 6 AM to 8 PM. The vote was: Ayes: Ron Parker, Nays: Roger Wheeler, Dave Newell, Randy Wigent and Judy Wheeler. The request was declared denied.

There was a discussion of the Zoning Administrator and some of the actions of the Zoning Administrator as well as some of the lack of actions by the Zoning Administrator. Supervisor Newell will have a discussion with the Zoning administrator.

There was a discussion of the problems that Attorney Kevin Shirk is having in serving papers to Wilmer Morgan.

There was a motion by Roger Wheeler, supported by Randy Wigent to pay bills and make payments for the month of June for a total amount of \$9,147.89. This motion carried 5-0.

There was a motion by Randy Wigent supported by Ron Parker to adjourn. This motion carried 5-0 and the meeting was adjourned at 8:45 PM.
