

Approved Minutes – Reading Township Board
October 11, 2004, Regular Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM with Dave Newell, Roger Wheeler, Judy Wheeler, Ron Parker and Randy Wigent present. Also present were Harold Farris, Kathy Mikolajczyk, James Galloway and Dick Gasser.

The minutes of the September 13, 2004 regular meeting were read and approved.

Dave Newell said that Road Commission Manager Stan Clingerman told him that the Rustic, Rus-Dic and Lake Drive project came in under budget.

There was a discussion of lots 14 & 15 of Wildwood Abode and the possibility of vacating a portion of Glen Lane east of these two lots.

Dick Gasser has been to the County researching the possibility of a condo being planned for the north side of Hemlock Lake in Allen Township. He said that there are no open permits but that there had been three sales of 25 or more acres.

There was a discussion of the walkways and lake access for back lot owners. It was indicated that someone had built a dock for a pontoon.

There was a motion by Roger Wheeler supported by Randy Wigent to pay bills and make payments for a total amount of \$28,647.23 plus the zoning administrator's expenses for the month of September, which was \$91.67. This motion carried 5-0.

Dave Newell reported that Lester Newell would not be mowing the cemeteries next year.

Dave Newell indicated that he would most likely not continue to manage the cemeteries after his term of Supervisor is up although he said that he might be willing to stay on for a short period of time.

Dick Gasser offered to serve on the Board of Review if an opening is available.

There was a motion by Randy Wigent supported by Ron Parker to adjourn. This motion carried 5-0 and the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.
