

Proposed Minutes – Reading Township Board
June 13, 2005, Regular Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM with James Galloway, Roger Wheeler and Judy Wheeler, Randy Wigent and Ron Parker present. The minutes of the May 9, 2005 regular meeting and the June 6, 2005 special meeting were approved as presented.

There was a motion by Roger Wheeler supported by James Galloway to table the Conditional use request by Crossroads Farm until the July meeting. This motion carried 5-0. There were however several questions asked of Dawn and Doug Routledge of Crossroads Farm.

Henry Risk presented a petition to the Board requesting that a road in the Hemlock Beech Sub-division be abandoned. The Township will have to research this to see how this might be handled.

The bills for Gravel road patching and the dust control will be held until the Township Supervisor has had a chance to discuss Road Commission and with JLM Tank Truck Service.

There is a meeting Scheduled for Thursday June 16, 2005 at 6:30 PM. Tim Johnson will again be present to assist in Master Plan development

Zoning Administrator, Harold Farris provided a verbal report to the board and noted that he had 256 miles on the May report.

There was a motion by Judy Wheeler supported by Ron Parker to donate the old AVM voting machines to the City of Reading to help in their effort to upgrade Waterworks Park. This motion carried 5-0.

To open up the bidding on the assessing services for Reading Township, some research will be done to see how other units put these services out for bid.

An appeals hearing will be held on Wednesday, June 29, 2005 at 7:00 PM.

There will be two Planning Commission hearings held on Tuesday, July 12, 2005. A hearing on a request for re-zoning a parcel of land will be held at 6:30 PM on July 12 and then at 7:30 there will be a hearing for a conditional use request.

There was a motion by Roger Wheeler supported by Randy Wigent to pay bills and make payments for a total amount of \$8,995.43. This motion carried 5-0.

A suggestion was made to get additional chairs for the Township Hall and to provide air conditioning for the Hall's main meeting room.

There was a motion by Randy Wigent supported by Judy Wheeler to adjourn. This motion carried 5-0 and the meeting was adjourned at 7:42 PM.
