

Approved Minutes – Reading Township Board  
June 9, 2008, Regular Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM with James Galloway, Roger Wheeler, Ron Parker and Judy Wheeler present. Randy Wigent absent. Also present were Suzanne Alexander, Kathy Mikolajczyk, Janice Garczynski and Harold Farris.

The minutes of the May 12, 2008 Regular meeting were approved as presented.

There were not any comments from guests.

There was a discussion of the road contracts with the Road Commission. All three of the contracts that have been signed with the Road Commission for this season have been completed.

The Road Commission will be putting fill at the intersection of Rood Road and Hakes Road preparing to make that intersection larger and more substantial. They will also be placing a new culvert on Wildwood Road.

There was not a Fire Department report for review at this meeting.

Township Zoning Inspector, Harold Farris presented his monthly report to the board along with a proposed letter drafted by Attorney Kevin Shirk, which can be sent to people in violation of the zoning ordinance.

The Zoning Inspector questioned how to handle situations where travel trailers are hooked up on a permanent basis. He was suggested that he follow the book on these. It was also brought up that a kennel license is required by anyone having three or more dogs.

There was not any other planning commission activity to report.

The tire cleanup project was discussed. A sign will be made to show the costs.

There was a motion by Roger Wheeler supported by James Galloway to pay bills and make payments of \$46,936.99 for the month of June. This motion carried 4-0.

An Election Commission meeting will be held after the regular July Township Board meeting. In August the terms of Planning Commission members Richard Heffelfinger and Kathy Mikolajczyk expire and the term of Board of Appeals member Kathy Mikolajczyk expires.

In other business, some of the Township Cemetery's equipment has been sold. The Trailer was sold for \$400, the John Deere 314 Riding Lawn Mower was sold for \$275 and the John Deere Lawn Cart was sold for \$151.

There was a motion by Roger Wheeler supported by Judy Wheeler to adjourn. This motion carried 4-0 and the meeting was adjourned at 7:26 PM.
