

Approved Minutes – Reading Township Board
August 7, 2008, Special Meeting

A special informational meeting was held at 7:00 PM, on August 7, 2008 at the new Headstart and CAA Office Bldg., 55 Barnard Street, Hillsdale, MI. This was a joint meeting of the Cambria Township Board, the Hillsdale Township Board and the Reading Township Board. The purpose of the meeting was to present to the township boards and explain and discuss the July 2008 draft by Wightman & Associates, Inc., of an Engineering Study for a Wastewater Collection and Treatment System that could serve portions of all three townships.

The three participating townships were represented by the following: Cambria Township had a quorum with Gary Reppert, Carol Rosales, IvaMay Butts and Eric Baumgartner present. Hillsdale Township had a quorum with Bill Vincent, Jackie Sullivan, Kelly Lantis, Tom Evans and Marvin Campbell present. Reading Township had a quorum with James Galloway, Randy Wigent, Judy Wheeler and Roger Wheeler present.

Others present to conduct this meeting and present information at this meeting were Tom Deneau and Matt Davis, both representing Wightman & Associates, Inc. and Christie Cook of the Rural Community Assistance Program. Helping to conduct this meeting were Tom Evans of Hillsdale Township, Gary Reppert of Cambria Township and James Galloway of Reading Township. There were approximately 160 other people present for this meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM.

Christie Cook of the Rural Community Assistance Program provided some background information on the development of the study.

Tom Deneau and then Matt Davis, both representing Wightman & Associates, Inc. provided a summary of a “Draft” of an “Engineering Study for a Wastewater Collection and Treatment System” for the Townships of Cambria, Hillsdale and Reading.

Following this presentation the three boards present were given an opportunity to ask question on the presentation and then others present were given an opportunity to ask questions.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:10 PM.

Following adjournment of the meeting everyone present was given an opportunity to ask individually specific questions of the presenters and also review the maps that were included in the “Draft”.
