

Proposed Minutes – Reading Township Board
June 8, 2009, Regular Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM with James Galloway, Roger Wheeler, Kimberly Blythe, Randy Wigent and Ron Parker present. Also present were Terry Vear, Wendy Crawford, Dick Mockensturn, Suzanne Alexander, Kathy Mikolajczyk, Gretchen Oberdick, Janice Garczynski, Vern Welch, Beverly Messenger, Roger Messenger, Hank Risk, Dorothy Risk and Harold Farris.

The minutes of the May 11, 2009 Regular meeting were approved as presented.

There were not any comments from guests.

Terry Vear, Executive Director of the Senior Services Center was present to hand out information packets and explain some of the services that are provided by the center along with some of the data on the use by area residents.

The Road Commission has now approved all three of the contracts that had been previously approved by the Township Board.

The Fire Truck is on order. Ron Parker informed the Board that the Firefighters Association has voted to commit to the purchase of the additional equipment for the new tanker where they would reimburse the City and the Township over several years for these additional costs.

Zoning Administrator, Harold Farris provided his monthly report.

The Planning Commission will be meeting on June 17th at 6:30 PM. The planning commission will be asked to consider possible revisions to the Zoning Ordinance so that wind generation equipment could be installed in agricultural districts of Reading Township.

There was a motion by Roger Wheeler supported by Kimberly Blythe to pay bills and make payments for the month of June for a total amount of \$3,867.83. This motion carried 5-0.

There was some discussion of a group project of seven or eight groups such as the Chamber of Commerce, the City and the Township to join in the purchase of a projector that could be used in such things as power point presentations. The approximate total cost would be \$800. The projector would be stored at the City office and would be available to any of the groups who support with the purchase. After this discussion a motion was made by Ron Parker and supported by James Galloway to pay up to \$150 toward this purchase. This motion carried 5-0.

The MTA has provided a “Principles of Governance” certificate, which can be signed by each of the board members. Once all of the correct names are on the certificate it will be presented to the board for signatures.

There was a motion by Randy Wigent supported by Kimberly Blythe to adjourn. This motion carried 5-0 and the meeting was adjourned at 7:43 PM.
