

Approved Minutes – Reading Township Board  
September 14, 2009, Regular Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM with James Galloway, Roger Wheeler, Kimberly Blythe, Randy Wigent and Ron Parker present. Also present were Kathy Mikolajczyk, Janice Garczynski, Gretchen Oberdick, Mike Parney, Roger Messenger, Beverly Messenger, Hank Risk, Dorothy Risk and Harold Farris.

The minutes of the August 10, 2009 Regular meeting were approved as presented.

Road Commissioner, Mike Parney was present and discussed the two projects that had been recently prepared by the Road Commission. Those were the speed zone sign on Ridge Drive and the Hakes Road safety project. After that discussion a motion was made by Roger Wheeler and supported by Randy Wigent to sign the proposed contract to place a speed zone sign on Ridge Drive at a cost to the Township of \$250. This motion carried 5-0. A motion was then made by Ron Parker and supported by Kym Blythe to approve the revised proposed contract that will be the first phase of work on Hakes Road at Rood Road. This would be at a cost to the Township of \$9,750. This motion carried 5-0.

The new Fire Truck will be delivered by the end of September. Supervisor Galloway reminded everyone of the training that will be necessary.

There will be a fire board meeting on Wednesday, October 7, 2009 at 6:00 PM in the Township Hall.

Zoning Administrator, Harold Farris gave his monthly report.

James Galloway will begin to get quotes on slips for dumpsters at the proposed transfer station site.

There was a motion by Roger Wheeler supported by Randy Wigent to pay bills and make payments for the month of September for a total amount of \$18,101.84. This motion carried 5-0.

Beverly Messenger asked about who is responsible for keeping people from blocking walkways and putting no trespassing signs at the walkways. Supervisor Galloway explained that the walkways were dedicated to all of the property owners within the plat and it is therefore the responsibility of the property owners within the plat to enforce these right a ways.

It is thought that at the October meeting an extension should be considered for the two-month agreement with the Montgomery Rescue people for first responder calls within the township.

There was a motion by Randy Wigent supported by Kimberly Blythe to adjourn. This motion carried 5-0 and the meeting was adjourned at 7:28 PM.
