

Approved Minutes – Reading Township Board
July 12, 2010, Regular Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:03 PM with James Galloway, Roger Wheeler, Randy Wigent, Kimberly Blythe and Ron Parker. Also present were William Bishop, Kathy Flaughter Leslie Tonnies, Gary Lovett, Ron Soares, Dick Heffelfinger, Roger Messenger, Beverly Messenger, Hank Risk, Dorothy Risk, Janice Garczynski, Kathy Mikolajczyk and Harold Farris.

The minutes of the June 14, 2010 Regular meeting were approved as presented.

Kathy Mikolajczyk asked if future Road Stabilization projects could be done earlier in the season.

Kathy Flaughter asked about whose responsible for maintaining the drive to the public access. This is the responsibility of the Department of Natural Resources.

Supervisor Galloway had talked with Road Commission Manager, Stan Clingerman about the dust control on Cole Road. Cole Road is for the most part on the boundary between Reading and Allen Townships and is normally shared between townships however Allen Township is not doing any dust control this year.

A Fire Board meeting is scheduled for August 4, 2010.

Zoning Administrator, Harold Farris provided a monthly report. Zoning packets will now be available at the City Hall. There was a motion by Galloway supported by Wigent to provide a cell phone to the Zoning Administrator. That motion carried 5-0.

Gary Lovett up-dated the board on a proposed wind ordinance and provided an explanation of sound levels. On Monday July 19, 2010 at 6:30 the Planning Commission will meet and there will be a presentation on sound.

The Board will continue to consider adding Time & Material and Travel to fees for Conditional uses, Site Plan Reviews, Board of Appeals and Zoning Amendments.

There was a motion by Blythe supported by Galloway to adopt Cemetery Rules and Regulations as proposed. This motion carried 5-0. The Board will also consider a damage claim for the storm damage at the West Reading Cemetery.

There was a motion by Galloway supported by Wigent to re-appoint Kimberly Blythe to the Library Board with the term to expire on December 31, 2012. This motion carried 5-0.

There was a motion by Roger Wheeler supported by Randy Wigent to pay bills and make payments for the month of June for a total amount of \$4,277.21. The motion carried 5-0.

Next month the board will need to make appointments or reappointments to the Planning Commission and Board of Appeals (Ron Parker's and Don Richardson's terms on the Planning Commission expire in August) (Doug Hick's term on the Zoning Board of Appeals and Jon Burrell's term as an alternate on the Zoning Board of Appeals expire in August). It has been suggested that Doug Hicks and Jon Burrell switch positions so that Doug Hicks would become an alternate.

Gary Lovett is resigning from the Board of Review. The Township Board will need to accept his resignation at the August meeting and look for a replacement to fill his term. All three BOR terms expire at the end of this calendar year.

There was a motion by Randy Wigent supported by Kim Blythe to adjourn. This motion carried 5-0 and the meeting was adjourned at 7:59 PM.
