

Village of Waldron Smoke-Free Facilities and Vehicles Policy

The U.S. Surgeon General, the National Research Council, and the National Academy of Science report that secondhand tobacco smoke causes lung cancer in healthy adult nonsmokers. These agencies have also found that separating smokers and nonsmokers within the same air space may reduce, but does not eliminate, a nonsmoker's exposure to secondhand tobacco smoke. Further, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency finds that secondhand tobacco smoke is a Group A Carcinogen – a category reserved for known cancer-causing agents in humans.

Based on these facts and the Village of Waldron's concern for the health and welfare of its employees, the Village of Waldron hereby enacts a "No Smoking Policy" effective August 10, 2004. As of this date, there shall be no smoking permitted within any part of any enclosed building, structure, or vehicle owned, leased, or operated by the Village of Waldron.
